

## COVID-19 Small Business Survey: Small Business Concerns + Policy Recommendations March 23, 2020

### WHO ARE SMALL BUSINESSES

- Small businesses are at the center of the American economy
  - o 30 million small businesses
  - 6 million small businesses employ 60 million people
  - 24 million small business owners are self-employed
  - 80% of small businesses have fewer than 10 employees



### ABOUT BUSINESSES FOR RESPONSIBLE TAX REFORM

- Businesses for Responsible Tax Reform formed in 2017 to call for policy reforms that truly benefit America's small business owners
- A coalition of business leaders dedicated to ensuring tax reform is fiscally responsible, creates a level playing field for all businesses and grows the economy






## SURVEY OUTLINE

- On March 22-23, 2020, BRTR conducted a survey of more than 500 small business owners in the BRTR network to learn about their needs and concerns during the COVID-19 pandemic
- Results found the need for urgent action from Congress



### **RESULTS: SEVERE IMPACT TO SMALL BUSINESS**

- 91% of survey respondents say COVID-19 has directly impacted their business
- 88% of respondents have lost revenue due to the pandemic
  nearly 70% say they have lost 50% or more of their revenue





### **RESULTS: SEVERE IMPACT TO SMALL BUSINESS**

 80% of survey respondents saying they face cash flow challenges because of the pandemic


### **RESULTS: SEVERE IMPACT TO SMALL BUSINESS**

- For survey respondents whose businesses are in "shelter-in-place" regions, 40% have been forced to close
- For businesses that <u>aren't</u> in shelter-in-place regions, 30% have experienced such sharp drops in customer demand that they have been forced to close
  - For businesses still open, 17% have been forced to lay off
    employees and 38% have had to cut hours for employees



### **RESULTS: POLICY NEEDS**

 Nearly 90% of survey respondents would support Congress creating unrestricted federal grants to businesses with 50 or fewer employees

## **RESULTS: POLICY NEEDS**

- 87% would support a deferral of interest and payments on all federallybacked small business loans for at least six months and encouragement for traditional banks to do the same
- More than 80% would support requiring lenders to refinance all federallybacked small business loans with lower interest, longer-term loans with no refinancing fees and encouragement for traditional banks to do the same



### **RESULTS: POLICY NEEDS**

- 80% would support direct stimulus payments to individuals with incomes of \$125,000 or below and to families making \$250,000 or below
- Small businesses will also need relief over the long-term. One such solution, a payroll tax abatement or deferral program, earns nearly 85% support
